

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS. ONLINE SHORT COURSES

WHAT DOES FULLY FUNDED REALLY MEAN?

Fully funded really is what it says on the tin.

The Government has a pot of money called the Adult Education Budget. This is set aside specifically for the training and upskilling of UK residents, which if you're applying for one of our online short courses, that's you.

IS THERE ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA?

There is an eligibility criteria for the funding but it's super simple.

- 19+ as of 31st August
- If 19-23 you must have already attained a full level 2 qualification to apply for level 2+
- Employed or unemployed
- Committed to completing the course within 8-weeks of start date
- Living legally in the UK or EU for 3 years
- Not on any other fully funded programme

IT SAYS MY AREA ISN'T FUNDED?

We only have funding available in certain areas.

We can fund those that live within non-devolved areas of England, West Yorkshire, Liverpool and Greater Manchester. An easy way to check this is by using our enrolment form to check what we have available in your area.

WHY DO YOU NEED TO KNOW IF I'M EMPLOYED OR UNEMPLOYED?

Your employment status and earnings will not affect your eligibility for the courses. Usually, if you are aged 24 and above and paid more than the annual national living wage, you would have to contribute 50% towards the cost of this qualification.

However, because we are committed to giving you the qualifications you need when you need them, we have decided as a business to make funding available for the full cost of this qualification regardless of your age. This allows you to purely focus on obtaining your qualification and making an impact on your future.

CAN I STILL ENROL IF I HAVE A HIGHER-LEVEL QUALIFICATION?

Yes, you can still complete the courses regardless of your prior attainment, as long as it is not the same qualification.

IS THERE A LIMIT ON THE NUMBER OF COURSES I CAN COMPLETE?

There isn't a limit on how many you can complete, however for funding purposes we ask that you only complete one course at a time.

HOW LONG DOES THE COURSES TAKE TO COMPLETE?

We give you 3 months to complete your qualification, which equals 8-weeks. This time starts from when you have completed your enrolment as you will be able to get started on your course straight away.

WHAT WILL I RECIEVE AFTER COMPLETING MY COURSE?

You will receive a nationally recognised accredited qualification from the awarding organisation upon successful completion of the qualification. The certificate usually takes around 6-8 weeks to be delivered after you have completed and signed your exit review but if you need it before, let us know and we can download your e-certificate for you.

HOW IS THE COURSE DELIVERED?

Course deliver is majority all online and learner led, unless you have agreed otherwise. All our learner is on something called e-assessorpro and is accessible 24/7 to you. This contains all your workbooks, content, questions, feedback and units. You will also receive tutor support throughout your time on programme to make sure you have all the support you need to keep on track.
