Staying Safe Online


Here are five key points to help keep your personal details safe online.


The rise of Artificial Intelligence (AI) has brought about significant improvements in various industries and transformed the way we live and work. However, with the increasing use of AI, it has become more critical than ever to keep our personal information safe online.

-  **Use Strong Passwords:**

-  **Watch out for Phishing Scams:**

Cybercriminals often use phishing scams to trick individuals into divulging their personal information. Be cautious of emails or messages that request sensitive data or ask you to click on a link or download a file.
-  **Make sure to use Encryption:**

When sending or receiving sensitive data online, ensure that the connection is encrypted. Encryption makes it more difficult for cybercriminals to intercept and access your data by scrambling it during transmission.
