ELCAS Funding



What is ELCAS Funding?

The MOD Enhanced Learning Credits Scheme (ELCAS) provides financial support for Armed Forces personnel and service leavers to gain recognised qualifications. Funding applies to Level 3 and above courses delivered by approved training providers. Total Training Provision are an approved provider and can be found on the ELCAS registry (14520) [ELCAS - Enhanced Learning Credits Administration Services](#)

How Much Funding Can You Get?

A) Fully Funded First Qualification

If eligible, you can receive 100% funding for:

- Your first Level 3 qualification (A-Level equivalent), or
- Your first higher education qualification (e.g., undergraduate degree). No personal contribution is required.

B) Standard ELC Credits (80% Funding)

For all other Level 3+ courses:

- ELCAS covers 80% of course fees.
- You pay the remaining 20%.
- Funding is capped depending on your tier:

Eligibility

Only service completed after 1 April 2000 counts toward eligibility. Funding is available to service leavers and those still serving in their qualifying resettlement phase.

How Many Claims Can You Make?

- One claim per financial year (1 April – 31 March).
- Up to three ELC claims total.
- Fully funded first-qualification support can only be used once.

Claim Requirements

You must submit a Claim Authorisation Note (CAN) before the course start date.
