## Standard Learning Credits (SLC)

### Who Can Use It?

- Regular service personnel
- Reservists (subject to eligibility)
- Those in the process of resettlement

### What It Covers:

- Up to £175 per financial year
- Must contribute at least 20% of the course cost
- Can be used in conjunction with other funding sources
- Courses must enhance personal or professional development but do not need to be directly job-related

### Key Points:

- Can be used annually
- Must be approved by your Education Officer
- Cannot be used for courses already funded by other MOD schemes
- Often used for short courses, certificates, or introductory qualifications

## Individual Resettlement Training Costs (IRTC)

### Who can use it:

- Service leavers with resettlement entitlement (usually 6+ years of service or medical discharge)

### What It Covers:

- Up to £534 towards training (daily allowance covers up to 20 days of training)
- Can be used for civilian-recognised qualifications, vocational training, or professional development
- Can be combined with Graduated Resettlement Time (GRT)

### Key Points:

- Can be used for both MOD-approved and external training providers
- Must be booked through your Resettlement Advisor
- Often used for trade qualifications, project management, health & safety, or technical skills
