The broad purpose of the occupation is to work and interact directly with children on a day to day basis supporting the planning of and delivery of activities, purposeful play opportunities and educational programmes within the ethos of the setting

An EYP works as part of a professional team ensuring the welfare and care for children under the guidance and supervision of an Early Years Educator, teacher or other suitably qualified professional the Early Years Workforce. In their daily work, an employee in this occupation interacts with parents, children, colleagues and wider multi agency professionals and partners such as health visitors, social workers and speech and language therapists

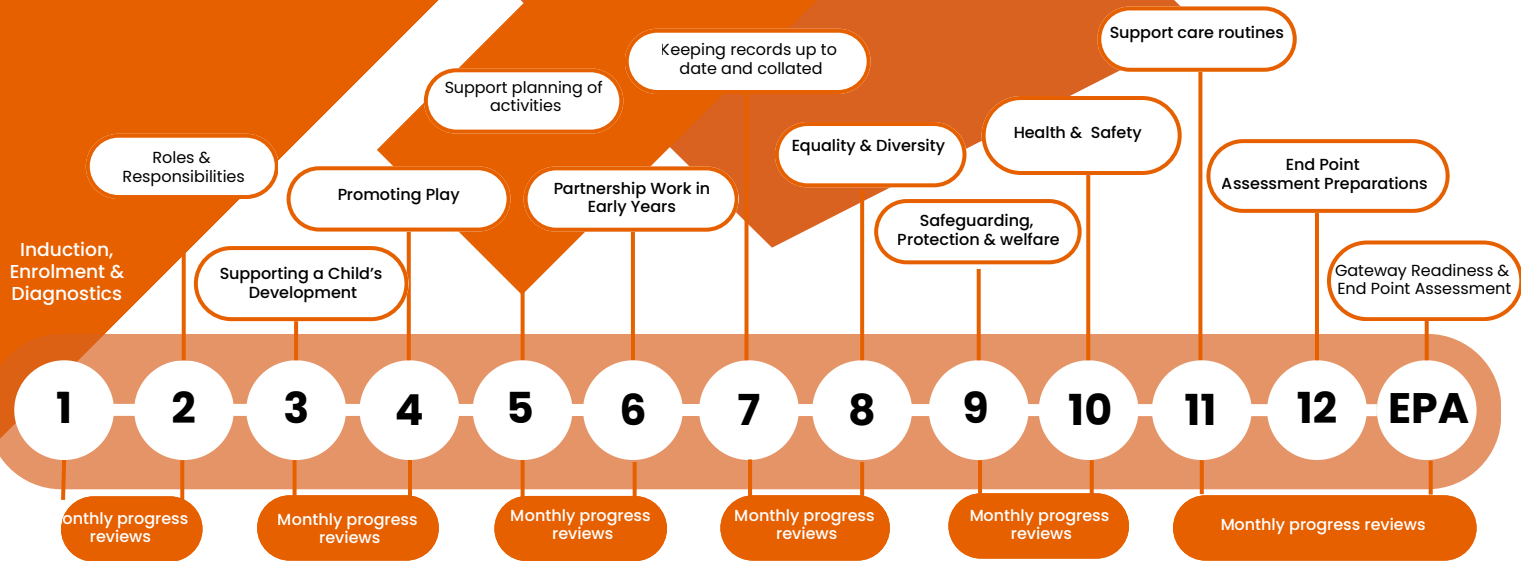
PROFESSIONAL DISCUSSION

The assessor holds a structured discussion with the apprentice about the portfolio of evidence compiled throughout the programme, demonstrating competence across the apprenticeship standard requirements

Project with Presentation

The apprentice completes a business-relevant project with real data that delivers insight or value; this is written up and submitted for assessment and used as the basis of a presentation.
